FROM MIDDLEBURG: TAKE RTE: 50W, CROSS SHENANDOAH RIVER BRIDGE. TAKE 2<sup>ND</sup> RIGHT AFTER BRIDGE ONTO MILLWOOD RD. (RTE. 723), THEN PROCEED ABOUT ½ MILE TO SANDSTONE ON RIGHT. TURN @ SANDSTONE SIGN.

FROM: LEESBURG: TAKE RTE 7W TO BERRYVILLE. GO LEFT ON RTE 340S. TAKE A LEFT ONTO RTE. 255 TOWARDS MILLWOOD. AT MILLWOOD, GO LEFT ONTO MILLWOOD RD. (RTE 723E). SANDSTONE ON LEFT.

FROM WINCHESTER: TAKE RTE 50E TO LEFT ONTO RTE 723 BEFORE SHENANDOAH RIVER BRIDGE. FARM IS ABOUT ½ MILE ON RIGHT.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

(In Addition to the General Rules of the WPCSA)

ELIGIBILITY: This show is open to ponies registered with and foals eligible for registration with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America. Person making entry and the eligibility of an animal shall be subject to the rules of the WPCSA and the Local Competition.

PAYMENT OF FEES: Only cash, checks or money orders payable in U.S. Currency will be accepted. A \$35.00 fee will be assessed for Non-Negotiable Checks. Fees must be paid in full with paperwork and signatures complete before numbers will be issued.

ENTRIES: Must be postmarked no later than April. 30, 2015 to be accepted. . All entries require Negative Coggins taken within one year of the date of the show. Copy of Pony Registration Papers and Measurement Cards MUST BE ATTACHED to the entry form. Incomplete entries will not be processed and will be returned.

SCRATCHES: Entry Fees (minus a \$10.00 per animal) will be refunded by mail ONLY UPON THE PRESENTATION OF A VET'S CERTIFICATE AND NOTIFICATION TO THE SHOW SECRETARY before the start of the show .

PRIZE MONEY: The prize money for this show totals \$240.00. \$10 will be given for each judge in the following divisions: Champions of Section A and Section B fillies, Colts, Stallions, Mares and Geldings; Grand Champions of Sections C/D and Half Welsh. Open classes will receive an award.

RIBBONS: Strip ribbons will be given. All classes will be placed 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup>. Look for results to be available on line after the show.

HEIGHT AND MEASUREMENT: All entries age 6 and over must present a measurement card from the USEF or WPCSA or be measured before getting your numbers to show. All ponies in performance classes must have a measurement card. Measurement will take place at 7:00 am on the day of the show. Non WPCSA members must pay a \$5 non-member measurement fee.

**COGGINS:** A negative Coggins test certificate, or copy thereof, within one year of the show is required!  
A Rhino vaccination is strongly recommended.

**DOGS:** Please leave your dogs and other pets at home. If they must come, they **MUST BE ON A LEASE OR BE CRATED.**

**BATHING PONIES:** This facility has no place for you to bathe your ponies.

**MOTORIZED VEHICLES:** There will be no motorized vehicles such as golf carts or scooters allowed on the grounds.

**PROTECTIVE HEAD GEAR:** Protective head gear **MUST** be worn by all mounted riders at all times.

**CLASSES:** May be divided at show management's discretion if entries warrant.

**FOOD:** You will need to bring you food and/or drinks. None are available on the showgrounds.

**STABLING:** Please note that there is NO stabling available on the showgrounds. Independent arrangements can be made off grounds if necessary. Please call 540-429-6925.

**JUNIOR EXHIBITORS:** **MUST** wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a pony drawn vehicle at all times while on the show grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

**EVERY PRECAUTION** will be taken for the safe keeping of every animal and article upon the grounds. Show management, employees, officials, volunteers or Sandstone Farm will in no case be responsible for any damage or accident which may occur. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for their own liabilities if incurred, as well as damage or injury to any other person or property, caused by the exhibitor or any of the animals exhibited by him/her.

Judged on the ability and skill of the Junior in handling their animal as in the breed ring. The show qualities of the animal shall not be considered, although cleanliness and grooming can be considered. Exhibitors enter to the left so as not to obscure the judge's view. The judge evaluates the ability of the junior to follow directions, use space wisely, and execute the requested patterns. Juniors should appear "ring wise", be alert to the judging progression and be prepared to changes in the judging routine.

- 64. *Open Pleasure Under Saddle – Open to all. Walk/trot/canter both ways o the ring. To stand quietly and back readily. Judged on manners, obedience, and ability to give a safe, pleasurable ride.*
- 65. *Open Pleasure Over Fences – Open to all. To jump a course of six fences at 2’ to 2’3”.* To be judged on willingness and on natural ability to jump with emphasis on manners.
- 66. *Shamrock Green Connemara Hack. Purebred and halfbred Connemaras as their first or second show. Walk/trot both ways of the ring. Judged on willingness, obedience and way of going.*
- 67. *Shamrock Green Hunter Hack – W/trot both ways of the ring. Individually jump 2 fences at 2’.*
- 68. *Halfbred Green Connemara Under Saddle - Ponies in their first or second year of showing. Walk/Trot/Canter both ways of the ring. Judge may ask for a halt or back*
- 69. *Halfbred Green Connemara Over Fences. Eight fences at 2’ to 2’3”.* Trotting permitted.
- 70. *Long/Short Stirrup Under Saddle – Any age rider. To be shown both ways of the ring at the walk and trot. Judged on hands, seat, guidance, and control of mount. Riders first or second show – not for intermediate or advanced riders.*
- 71. *Long/Short Stirrup Over Fences – Any age rider. To be shown over course of four fences at 2’ to 2’3”.*
- 72. *Purebred Green Connemaras Under Saddle – Ponies in their first or second year of showing. Walk/trot/canter both ways of the ring. Judge may ask for a halt or back.*
- 73. *Purebred Green Connemaras Over Fences. Eight fences at 2’3”.* Trotting Permitted.

### *74. WPCSA LEADLINE WALK (Article 115.4)*

*Classes open to riders 7 & under mounted on Ponies/Cobs/Half-Welsh/Part Breds, mares and geldings. See rules for attachment of leading rein. No chain leadlines allowed. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount at a walk. To stand quietly. To be led by an adult or a junior age 12 or over. Both handler and rider to be appropriately attired. English or Western attire is acceptable. No chain leadlines. RIDERS ineligible for other*

*ridden classes except costume, leading rein, leadline walk-trot, and leadline walk-trot poles.*

75. WPCSA LEADLINE WALK-TROT (Article 115.4)

*Classes open to riders 7 & under mounted on Ponies/Cobs/Half-Welsh/Part Breds, mares and geldings. See rules for attachment of leading rein. No chain leadlines allowed. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount at a walk and trot/jog. To stand quietly. To be led by an adult or a junior age 12 or over. Both handler and rider to be appropriately attired. English or Western attire is acceptable. No chain leadlines. RIDERS ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, leadline walk and leadline walk-trot poles.*

76. WPCSA LEADLINE WALK-TROT POLES (Article 115.4)

*Classes open to riders 7 & under mounted on Ponies/Cobs/Half-Welsh/Part Breds, mares and geldings. See rules for attachment of leading rein. No chain leadlines allowed. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To be ridden once around a course of four poles on the ground entirely at a walk or entirely at a trot/jog. Poles are to be placed at a minimum of 4 feet off the rail, two on each side of the ring, simulating a hunter course. The poles should be placed far enough away from the entrance gate to provide an adequate sized area to do an opening and closing circle. To be led by an adult or a junior age 12 or over. Both handler and rider to be appropriately attired. English or Western attire is acceptable. No chain Leadlines. RIDERS ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, leadline walk and leadline walk-trot.*

77. WPCSA WALK (Article 115.5)

*Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on Ponies/Cobs/Half-Welsh/Part Breds, mares and geldings. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. English or Western attire is acceptable. RIDERS ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk-trot and walk-trot poles. To walk both ways of the ring.*

78. WPCSA WALK-TROT (Article 115.5)

*Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on Ponies/Cobs/Half-Welsh/ Part Breds, mares and geldings. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. Possible test to include: walk, trot/jog, turn, halt and rein back at spots marked. English or Western attire is acceptable. RIDERS ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk and walk/trot poles.*

79. WPCSA WALK-TROT POLES (Article 115.5)

*Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on Ponies/Cobs/Half-Welsh/Part Breds, mares and geldings. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To be ridden once around a course of four poles on the ground entirely at a walk or entirely at a trot/jog.*

*Poles are to be placed at a minimum of 4 feet of the rail, two on each side of the ring, simulating a hunter course. The poles should be placed far enough away from the entrance gate to provide an adequate sized area to do an opening and closing circle. English or Western attire is acceptable. RIDERS ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk and walk-trot.*

- 80. WPCSA LEADING REIN: Section A, B, C or Partbred/Half Welsh, mare or gelding, 12.2 hands and under, to be ridden by junior exhibitors at least four, but not more than eight years of age. Ponies to be judged on manners, suitability, breed type, conformation and turn-out. This is not an equitation class. There are no restrictions for the pony or rider.*
- 81. WPCSA CHILD'S FIRST PONY: Section A, B, C, or Partbred/Half Welsh mare or gelding 12.2 hands and under, to be ridden by junior exhibitors at least four; but no more than 12 years of age. Riders to be suitably dressed in Hunt, Saddle or Western attire including protective headgear. Ponies to show at a walk and trot or job, both ways of the ring. Ponies to be judged on performance, manners, suitability and turnout to be emphasized. This is not an equitation class. There are no restrictions for the pony or rider.*
- 82. OPEN WALK: Classes open to riders 11 & Under. Exhibitors must be mounted on mares or geldings. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. English or Western attire is acceptable RIDERS ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk-trot and walk-trot poles. To walk both ways of the ring.*
- 83. OPEN WALK-TROT Classes open to riders 11 & Under. Exhibitors must be mounted on mares or geldings. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. Possible test to include: walk, trot/jog, turn, halt and rein back at spots marked. English or Western attire is acceptable. RIDERS ineligible for other ridden classes.*
- 84. OPEN WALK-TROT POLES : Classes open to riders 11 & Under . Exhibitors must be mounted on mares or geldings. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To be ridden once around a course of four poles on the ground entirely at a walk or entirely at a trot/jog. Poles are to be placed at a minimum of 4 feet of the rail, two on each side of the ring, simulating a hunter course. The poles should be placed far enough away from the entrance gate to provide an adequate sized area to do an opening and closing circle. English or Western attire is acceptable. RIDERS ineligible for other ridden classes.*
- 85. OPEN WALK: Classes open to riders 12-17. Exhibitors must be mounted on mares or geldings. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. English or Western attire is acceptable RIDERS ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk-trot and walk-trot poles. To walk both ways of the ring.*



86. *OPEN WALK-TROT: Classes open to riders 12-17. Exhibitors must be mounted on mares or geldings. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. Possible test to include: walk, trot/jog, turn, halt and rein back at spots marked. English or Western attire is acceptable. RIDERS ineligible for other ridden classes.*
87. *OPEN WALK-TROT POLES : Classes open to riders 12-17. Exhibitors must be mounted on mares or geldings. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To be ridden once around a course of four poles on the ground entirely at a walk or entirely at a trot/jog. Poles are to be placed at a minimum of 4 feet of the rail, two on each side of the ring, simulating a hunter course. The poles should be placed far enough away from the entrance gate to provide an adequate sized area to do an opening and closing circle. English or Western attire is acceptable. RIDERS ineligible for other ridden classes.*
88. *OPEN WALK: Classes open to riders 18+. Exhibitors must be mounted on mares or geldings. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. English or Western attire is acceptable. 89. *OPEN WALK-TROT: Classes open to riders 18+. Exhibitors must be mounted on mares or geldings. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. Possible test to include: walk, trot/jog, turn, halt and rein back at spots marked. English or Western attire is acceptable. RIDERS ineligible for other ridden classes.*
90. *OPEN WALK-TROT POLES : Classes open to riders 18+ . Exhibitors must be mounted on mares or geldings. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To be ridden once around a course of four poles on the ground entirely at a walk or entirely at a trot/jog. Poles are to be placed at a minimum of 4 feet of the rail, two on each side of the ring, simulating a hunter course. The poles should be placed far enough away from the entrance gate to provide an adequate sized area to do an opening and closing circle. English or Western attire is acceptable. RIDERS ineligible for other ridden classes.*

*WPCSA ENGLISH PLEASURE: To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring on light contact without martingale. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25% on breed type and conformation. Working classes are judged 100% on performance.*
