



# DESCHUTES COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS EXHIBITOR RULES & REGULATIONS

To assist the Show Management and to ensure a smooth and successful show, all exhibitors are asked to read and adhere to the following rules.

- 1. Manure pits are located behind the barns.
  - ·Exhibitors must wheelbarrow shavings and manure into the manure pits.
  - ·Keep the paved roadways & areas around the manure pits clean of straw & manure by picking up spillage.
  - ·Manure pits will be emptied as they become full.
  - Only shavings and manure are to be placed in manure pits.
  - Garbage cans will be provided for string, wire, horseshoes, feed bags, rubbish, etc.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHOULD SHAVINGS AND MANURE BE PUSHED OR PLACED ONTO ANY PAVED SURFACE AREAS OR INSIDE THE BARNS.

- 2. Vehicles not used in an event must be **parked away from buildings** to allow for emergency access to front and back of buildings.
- 3. **NO HORSES ARE ALLOWED ON THE GRASS.** A charge may be assessed if damage to grass occurs or clean up is required. Exercise and work your horses in warm-up areas.
- 4. **DO NOT DEFACE** buildings by stapling posters, flyers or other decorations. Do not use duct, scotch or masking tape on floors or walls.
- 5. The **speed limit** on the grounds is not to exceed 10 mph.
- 6. **ALL DOGS** are to be kept on leash. Dogs are NOT ALLOWED in the buildings or on the lawn areas, except Seeing Eye, Medic Alert, 4-H show, or sport and wildlife events. Security dogs need pre-approval by fairgrounds management. WALK YOUR DOG IN THE DESIGNATED AREA ONLY AND **CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG.**
- 7. NO SMOKING IN BUILDINGS (includes restrooms).
- 8. **Do not block** power receptacles, fire extinguishers, emergency exits or water faucets.
- 9. **Remove all event materials and equipment** from buildings and fairgrounds unless prior arrangements have been made.

VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE FAIRGROUND RULES COULD RESULT IN FINES AND/OR IMMEDIATE EXPULSION FROM THE SHOWGROUNDS.

#### GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

"Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith."

#### **USEF MEMBERSHIP RULE:**

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 show pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

#### **USEF ENTRY AGREEMENT:**

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules.

I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

A copy of the appropriate, current USEF membership card(s) must be sent with entries. If a copy of the card(s) does not accompany the entry or is not presented upon checking in, and cannot be verified at the show office, then a member must pay a \$30 show pass fee.

**AMATEUR CERTIFICATION:** Every person who has reached his 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation (except non-USEF breeds). USEF Chapter 13. Certification must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the Competition Secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such certification provided by the Federation.

**ARENA SCHEDULE:** The arenas will be closed each night at 11:00 p.m. and open by 6:30 a.m.. The arenas will also be closed 1 hour before each session.

ARRIVALS & DEPARTURE: Stall fees cover the following dates ONLY: Monday, June 13 through Sunday, June 19, 2016. If ARRIVING EARLIER than Monday or DEPARTING LATER than Sunday afternoon, you MUST MAKE ARRANGEMENTS with show management. There will be an early arrival fee of \$25.00 per night per stall occupied by horses. Please add this to your entry blank.

**AWARDS:** Trophy to first place and ribbons to sixth place will be awarded to all Morgan classes. Ribbons to sixth place awarded to all others. Ribbons to eighth place will be awarded in Championships. Division of money classes shall be as listed below. Prize money will be distributed no later than 30 days after the close of the show.

**CHANGE OR CANCELLATION:** Management has the right to combine, cancel or split any classes it deems appropriate. Management reserves the right to reschedule any class for the overall good of the show, exhibitors to be notified as per USEF rules.

**CLASS ANNOUNCEMENTS:** Please be aware class calls are a courtesy to the exhibitor. Show management is not responsible for an exhibitor missing a class, although every effort will be made to maintain a working P.A. system.

**CONDUCT:** The Horse Protection Act of 1970, Public Law 91-540 as amended will be followed. Exhibitors are cautioned as to their conduct in the ring and in the schooling areas, especially with respect to training and schooling horses. Use of all rubber or elastic devices on legs are prohibited on the show grounds before or during this show. Violators will forfeit all trophies, ribbons and premiums previously won and will be barred from any further competition, and will have absolutely no recourse against the management of this show and its officials.

**DIVIDING OF CLASSES:** It is at the manager's discretion to split qualifying classes of 18 or more entries. Both sections will be pinned. Championship classes being split will have a call back to pin one champion. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to check to see that they have been entered in the proper class and split section.

**DRUGS & MEDICATION:** In compliance with the USEF Drug and Medication Rule, a \$16.00 fee will be collected on all horses entered, including equitation horses (except non-USEF breeds). The Drugs and Medications fee has been incorporated into the USEF Fee and will continue to be assessed per horse, per competition. This includes the \$8.00 drug fee and a \$8.00 USEF fee. The Show Committee has requested USEF to test these shows for use of forbidden substances.

**ENTRIES:** MUST BE POSTMARKED MAY 23, 2016 to be included in the show program. No Dressage entries will be accepted after May 31, 2016. All entry blanks must be signed by Owner, Trainer and each Rider/Driver/Handler and Coach (if applicable). No one under 18 may sign. **No entries will be accepted without payment.** 

ENTERING CLASSES DURING THE SHOW: Any class entered during the show must be entered ONE HOUR before the session in which the class is to be held.

CHANGE IN ENTRIES: Where exhibitors, trainers or stables wish to make a change in entries in any class, they are required to follow the procedure of scratching the existing entry and making a new entry with the Show Secretary's Office.

**FACILITY AND FOOTING:** Bank of the Cascades Show Arena is 125' x 300'; warm-up arena is 100' x 200'; Sagebrush Arena is 150' x 300'. Footing is volcanic soil and sandy loam in all arenas with the exception of Sagebrush arena which has barkdust added.

**FEED AND BEDDING:** Please order on your entry blank. Additional shaving and feed orders can be placed during the week from K&D Shavings on the show grounds.

**GOLF CARTS:** Rentals are available through the horse show only. You may order them on the entry blank. Order deadline is June 1, 2016.

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**HORSE SHOW OFFICE**: opens Monday, June 13<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 p.m. Contact number is 316-650-2287.

PERSONS NOT IN GOOD STANDING: PERSONS WHO ARE NOT IN GOOD STANDING WITH AMHECT OR AMHA may not participate in this show, whether as an exhibitor, owner, trainer or otherwise. This policy includes all horses registered in the name of any such person, whether leased or under contract for sale. Procedures have been established to resolve any disputes concerning accounts with AMHECT or AMHA. Entries from persons having a debt to any other Regional show or the Grand National & World Championship Morgan Horse Show® may be refused until indebtedness is settled.

**POST ENTRIES** will be accepted after the closing date at no additional cost. No post entry fee will be charged for classes entered at the show if they are entered at least one hour before session in which the class is held. **UPON PAYMENT OF A \$50.00 FEE, in addition to the class entry fee, entries will be accepted up to the time the class is entering the ring.** THERE WILL BE NO DRESSAGE ENTRIES ACCEPTED AFTER MAY 31, 2016.

#### PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR:

- Riders in all classes where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds must wear protective headgear (Exception: Trail classes).
- All juniors riding in Hunter Seat Equitation sections, while riding anywhere on the competition grounds, must wear properly fitting protective headgear which passes or surpasses ASTM/SEI standards. Harness must be secured and properly fitted.
- Anyone mounted on a horse entered in Dressage classes must wear protective headgear except those riders age 18 & over while on horses that are competing only in FEI levels and tests at the Prix St. Georges level and above. When cross

entry by rider or horse/rider combination is permitted between Dressage and other classes at a competition, DR120 and DR 121 apply only to the designated Dressage warm-up and competition areas or when exhibitor is actually warming up for Dressage classes.

- Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear in any division or class without penalty by the judge.
- All junior exhibitors in Welsh Pony classes must wear protective headgear (ASTM/ SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times while on the show ground. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

**PROTESTS:** As per USEF Chapter 6, Protests may be made to the Show Committee by an exhibitor, owner, agent, trainer or the parent of a junior exhibitor for any violation of USEF rules. It must be in writing, signed by the protester, addressed to the secretary of the competition at which the alleged violation occurred, accompanied by a deposit of \$200.00 (\$300 if made by a non-member) and received by the steward, technical delegate, a member of the Show Committee, the competition manager or the competition secretary within 48 hours of the alleged violation.

**REFUNDS:** If horses are scratched prior to the entry deadline, all fees will be refunded. After the deadline, class entry fees only will be refunded if a veterinarian certificate is received before the start of the show. Stall fees will not be refunded.

**REGISTRATION:** All horses in breed-specific classes must be registered with their respective registries. For specific information, see the Classes by Section portion of the prize list.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** All exhibitors in the horse show will be under the control and direction of the Show Management and said Management will not be responsible for loss, injury or damage to horses exhibited or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or in anyway damaged. You may report lost articles to the Show Secretary.

**SHARPS DISPOSAL:** It is the responsibility of each individual stable to properly dispose of needles, syringes and other bio-hazardous materials. Sharps containers will be placed in the barns. Please use them to dispose of these items.

STALLS/STABLING: Permanent and portable stalls with doors will be available. Bedding is the responsibility of the exhibitor and may be pre-ordered by the official supplier. There will be a charge for any stall damage. Nailing, drilling or poking holes in panels or frames is NOT ALLOWED. Stall assignments will be made at the sole discretion of the show management. INDIVIDUAL EXHIBITORS REQUESTING TO BE STABLED WITH A TRAINER MUST BE IN TRAINING WITH THAT TRAINER, AND HAVE THE TRAINER SIGN THE STABLING LIST AND SIGN THE ENTRY.

**TRAILERS/ HORSE VANS: EMPTY HORSE TRAILERS** must be parked in designated areas only. Please cooperate so we don't have to tow your trailer to a new location.

**EQUIPMENT OF HORSE:** School bridles, full bridles, running martingales and German martingales are all permissible equipment, along with the appropriate saddle for the division. Protective equipment such as shin boots, knee boots, run downs and saddle

pads are allowed. Training devices such as chains, stretchers and blinkers are not allowed in the warm-up or the show ring.

**CLASS DIVISIONS AND JUDGING CRITERIA:** Equitation is judged on basic seat, hands and form, along with effective control of the horse. Performance is judged on showmanship ability, ring generalship and presentation of the horse to its best ability. The horse is not judged. Headers are allowed in all classes after the Judge's card has been turned in. All Academy classes are open to both English and Western riders.

**RIDER ELIGIBILITY:** A rider is no longer eligible for Academy competition if he/she has shown in a full riding suit in any regular horse show class except driving classes. This applies to a rider that has competed in walk and trot and/or open classes in a full show suit. Riders may not cross enter into walk/trot classes if he/she has already competed in a walk, trot and canter class at the current or any other show.

**HORSE ELIGIBILITY:** A horse that is used in Academy competitions can be farm or privately owned. However, it must be used regularly in a professional lesson program. Horses can cross enter regular classes and Academy classes as long as the horse meets the Academy criteria. Classes are open to all breeds.

#### **WELSH PONY**

All ponies/cobs/Half-Welsh/Part-Bred must be registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America, Inc. or the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of Canada and must be entered under their full registered name, or if under one year, be eligible for registration. Copies of the Welsh Certificate of Registration must be submitted with entries. All ponies must have a measurement card issued by USEF (if six or older), or a copy of a current measurement form (if under six). Owners of ponies obtaining a measurement card at the show MUST be a member of USEF or join at the show. Removing the bridle from a animal harnessed to a vehicle or leaving an animal unattended while hitched, anywhere on the show grounds, will result in an instant elimination and removal from the show grounds.

Junior Exhibitors MUST wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times while on the show grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

### **WPCSA RIDDEN WELSH CLASSIC (Article 115.7)**

To be judged 50% on conformation and 50% on performance. Entries shall enter the arena in a clockwise direction. To be shown on both reins as a group at the walk, trot and canter with animation. The required individual performance must show all four gaits (the gallop need only be shown in one direction). Each animal will then be stripped and judged for conformation judging, showing at the walk and trot in hand, by the rider. Once an entry has been judged for conformation it may be retacked. English tack and attire only.

Championship is open to the first and second place winners from the Ridden Welsh A,B and the Ridden Welsh C,D. Any animal in this class is eligible to be named the Best Ridden. Entries shall enter the arena at the walk in a clockwise direction. The judge shall request all four gaits (walk, trot, canter, gallop) in at least one direction, but animals need not show in both directions. Judge shall consider the size of ponies, age of riders, safety of arena when determining whether to have the animals perform as a group or individually. Individual pattern is optional at the judge's discretion. Entries shall not be stripped as conformation score from the qualifying class shall be carried forward.



<u>USDF Membership Benefits</u>: USDF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and promotion of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the *USDF Member Guide* or the USDF website at www.usdf.oru.

This competition is recognized by USDF for 2016

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions; Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.) Individuals cannot compete at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition with a USDF Education Membership.

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NIM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or
  dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions
  (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this requirement. Also
  exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

#### Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$75), 5-years (\$300), or life (\$1,500). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$60). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequana (USDF Year-End Awards, Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders Championship Series Finals and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$200) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Education Membership (EM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. This online education only membership expires 12 months after the date joined. This membership type does NOT allow an individual to compete at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$25 per competition that must be

Non-member (Nm) identification number: For each USUF NM ownernessee and USUF NM neer mere will be a USUF. NM fee of \$25 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$25). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded, but will NOT be counted towards Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes or Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders Championship Series Finals. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$70. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$95) is eligible for Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders Championship Series Finals and Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.


#### How to Join USDF

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.

### TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS INTO OREGON

All horses entering Oregon from out of state (except Washington) must have an entry permit from the Oregon Department of Agriculture and a health certificate with identification. A negative EIA (Coggins) test (within 6 months prior to entry) is required for all states except Washington. There is no cost for entry permits and they are obtained from the Oregon Dept. of Agriculture, 635 Capitol Street NE, Salem, OR 97310, 503-986-4679. The Dept. of Agriculture will issue permits over the phone, but prefer that your veterinarian call with the Coggins report.
