Directions to Hardy Murphy Coliseum:

Heading North on I-35, take EXIT 29, toward Madill/Ardmore. Merge onto US-70 E toward Madill, go 2.7 miles, Turn Left on Lake Murray Drive/OK-77S, go 2.2 miles. Hardy Murphy Coliseum will be on your right.

Heading south on I-35, take EXIT 31A toward Ardmore. Go 2.6 miles; turn right onto S Washington St/OK-77S. Continue 1.1 miles following OK-77S. Stay right at T, Hardy Murphy Coliseum will be on you left.

Entry deadline is April 26, 2017 OFFICIAL RULES and Regulations

All participants showing in WPSCA classes will follow the General Rules and Show Rules for the WPCSA

1. A negative Coggins certificate or copy dated within one year of the show is required for ALL Horses & Ponies.

2. Payment of Fees: Only cash, check or Money Orders payable in US Currency will be accepted. Fees must be paid in full with paper work and signatures complete **before numbers will be issued**. You can include an open check with your entries or pay the day of the show. Please make checks payable to Johnson Performance Horses or JPH. Returned checks will be subject to a \$25 fee and must be cleared within 30 days of the last day of the show. Post entry fee is \$2 per class. Refund Policy: No refunds will be given unless a class is canceled, or upon presentation of a Vet Certificate/Doctor's note and notification to the Show Secretary before the start of the show. The Show Committee's discretion will be used in other instances. Decisions of Show Management are final.

3. **Exhibitors, parents and/or guardians of minor exhibitors** shall indemnify and hold harmless Johnson Performance Horses, Hardy Murphy Coliseum, show sponsors, employees and/or all horse show officials and employees or volunteers from any and all liability resulting in injury and/or loss sustained by any person, child or ward of such parent/guardian, in any manner occasioned. Be sure to sign the release of liability attached to your entry form.

4. **Ribbons**: Ribbons for 1-6th place will be given in all classes. Champion and Reserve Champion in all divisions will receive rosettes. Supreme Champion and Reserve Supreme Champion will receive a neck sash.

Prize Money: The prize money will be: \$20 will be awarded to each judge's Grand Champion Section A, Section B, Section C/D, Half-Welsh/Partbred, and Supreme Champion Gelding. Each judge's Supreme Champion will receive \$30, and Reserve Supreme will receive \$15. \$20 will be awarded to the winner of the Ridden Welsh Classic Championship. Prize money will be credited to your show bill.

Stake Classes: To qualify for entry, exhibitors must enter and compete in at least one other class in the division. All stake/jackpot classes will pay \$15 to first place, \$10 to second place. Classes with less than 3 entries do not pay out Stake money. Any divisions that are not filled (3 entries in all 3 classes) will not be awarded Championships.

5. Driving: For animals in harness, animals must be fully bridled while hitching and unhitching. Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched; anywhere on the show grounds will result in the instant elimination and removal from the show grounds.

6. All riders in any class where jumping is required and/or when jumping anywhere on the show grounds must wear protective headgear. Anyone violating this rule will be prohibited from further riding until in compliance. NOTE: Protective headgear is advised and welcome in all classes of any age group, with no judging penalties.

7. All dogs must be on a leash or secured at all times.

8. **ANY** abuse toward any animal or Show Official/Staff will be cause for immediate ejection from the show and premises, **WITHOUT REFUND.**

9. Management reserves unto itself the right to refuse or cancel any entries, disqualify riders, drivers or exhibitors without incurring claim for damages. Classes will be split where entries warrant. Decisions of the Show Management are final.

10. Two (2) Minute Gate Rule: To be strictly enforced. Additional three (3) minutes will be allowed for <u>requested tack change</u>. The Gate will not be held for more than five (5) minutes

12. **RV Parking** is available. Fee is \$35 nightly with hookups.

13. There will be a concession stand on the grounds.

Open classes - Open to horses and ponies of any breed and need not be registered.

Class Specifications

WPCSA JUNIOR WELSH HANDLER (Article 115.6)

Judged on the ability and skill of the Junior in handling their pony/cob/half-Welsh/Partbred as in the breed ring. The show qualities of the pony/cob/half-Welsh shall not be considered, although cleanliness and grooming can be considered. Exhibitors enter to the left so as not to obscure the judge's view. The judge evaluates the ability of the junior to follow directions, use space wisely, and execute the requested patterns. Juniors should appear "ring wise", be alert to the judging progression and be prepared for changes in the judging routine.

WPCSA BREED CLASSES (Article 110.2)

Animals are to be shown in hand at a walk and a trot except in group classes. Purebred Welsh to be judged 85% on breed type, conformation, way of going, quality and substance and 15% on disposition and manners. Natural reaching action is desired. Half-/partbred Welsh to be judged 85% on conformation, way of going, quality and substance and 15% on Welsh breed type, disposition and manners.

WPCSA LEADLINE WALK (Article 115.4)

Classes open to riders 7 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/Half-Welsh/Partbred mares and geldings. See rules for attachment of leading rein. No chain leadlines allowed. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount at a walk. To stand quietly. To be led by an adult or a junior age 12 or over. Both handler and rider to be appropriately attired. English or Western attire is acceptable. No chain leadlines. **RIDERS** ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, leadline walk-trot, and leadline walk-trot poles.

WPCSA LEADLINE WALK-TROT (Article 115.4)

Classes open to riders 7 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/Half-Welsh/Partbred mares and geldings. See rules for attachment of leading rein. No chain leadlines allowed. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount at a walk and trot/jog. To stand quietly. To be led by an adult or a junior age 12 or over. Both handler and rider to be appropriately attired. English or Western attire is acceptable. No chain leadlines. **RIDERS** ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, leadline walk and leadline walk-trot poles.

WPCSA LEADLINE WALK-TROT POLES (Article 115.4)

Classes open to riders 7 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/Half-Welsh/Partbred mares and geldings. See rules for attachment of leading rein. No chain leadlines allowed. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To be ridden once around a course of four poles on the ground entirely at a walk or entirely at a trot/jog. Poles are to be placed at a minimum of 4 feet off the rail, two on each side of the ring, simulating a hunter course. The poles should be placed far enough away from the entrance gate to provide an adequate sized area to do an opening and closing circle. To be led by an adult or a junior age 12 or over. Both handler and rider to be appropriately attired. English or Western attire is acceptable. No chain leadlines. **RIDERS** ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, leadline walk and leadline walk-trot.

WPCSA LEADING REIN (Article 115.1) - Section A, B, C, or Half Welsh/ Partbred, Mare or gelding, 12.2 and under, to be ridden by junior exhibitors at least four, but not more than 8 years of age. To be shown on light contact and led by an adult. See rules for attachment of leading rein. No chain leadlines allowed. To be shown at a walk, on the right rein (clockwise), to line up and stand quietly. Ponies will be called out individually to stand, walk out and trot or jog back past the judge. **Ponies to be judged** on manners, suitability, breed type, conformation and turnout. This is not an equitation class. **There are no restrictions for the pony or rider.**

WPCSA CHILD'S FIRST PONY (Article 115.2) - Section A, B, C, or Half Welsh/ Partbred, Mare or gelding, 12.2 and under, to be ridden by junior exhibitors at least four, but not more than 10 years of age. Riders to be suitability dressed in Hunt, Saddle, or Western attire including protective head gear. Ponies to be shown at a walk and trot or jog, both ways of the ring. **Ponies to be judged** on performance, manners and suitability. Conformation, way of going, manners, suitability and turnout to be emphasized. This is not an equitation class. **There are no restrictions for the pony or rider.**

WPCSA WALK (Article 115.5)

Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/Half-Welsh/Partbred mares and geldings. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. English or Western attire is acceptable. **RIDERS** ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk-trot and walk-trot poles. To walk both ways of the ring.

WPCSA WALK-TROT (Article 115.5)

Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/Half-Welsh/Partbred mares and geldings. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. Possible test to include: walk, trot/jog, turn, halt and rein back at spots marked. English or Western attire is acceptable. **RIDERS** ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk and walk-trot poles.

WPCSA WALK-TROT POLES (Article 115.5)

Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/Half-Welsh/Partbred mares and geldings. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To be ridden once around a course of four poles on the ground entirely at a walk or entirely at a trot/jog. Poles are to be placed at a minimum of 4 feet off the rail, two on each side of the ring, simulating a hunter course. The poles should be placed far enough away from the entrance gate to provide an adequate sized area to do an opening and closing circle. English or Western attire is acceptable. **RIDERS** ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk and walk-trot.

WPCSA TRAIL (Article 115.3) Open to all ponies/cob/Half-Welsh/Partbred. English or Western equipment. To be shown over and through obstacles at a walk, optional trot or jog and optional canter or lope. To be judged 100% on performance.

OPEN PET PONY OBSTACLE-Open to all ponies and breeds- To be shown in-hand over and through obstacles at a walk and trot, by handlers 8 and under. To be judged 100% on performance.

OPEN IN-HAND TRAIL-Open to all breeds of horses and ponies, as well as handlers of all ages! To be shown in-hand over and through obstacles at a walk and trot. To be judged 100% on performance.

WPCSA PLEASURE DRIVING (Article 113.1)

To be shown to a suitable two or four-wheeled vehicle or four-wheeled vehicle for pairs, but not a viceroy, racing sulky or fine harness rig. Use of a bike style vehicle with floorboards and a basket is acceptable. To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, working trot and trot on and stand quietly and except for tandems, **to back readily**. A properly attired groom or passenger *capable of rendering assistance in case of an emergency* is required for all pairs and tandems; unicorns and four-in-hands require 2 grooms/passengers. Failure to comply will result in elimination from the class. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25% on breed type and conformation. Working classes are judged 100% on performance.

WPCSA SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER (Article 112.6)

Division is open to riders 12 years and under. Classes are open to all ponies/cobs/half-/Partbred Welsh, mares and geldings. **RIDERS** in this division, including the under saddle class, may not compete over fences in any other division except Short Stirrup equitation. Courses to be

set at 18" with a minimum of 4 fences with 8 jumping efforts required. May either trot or canter the course. Over-fence classes must precede the under-saddle class. To be judged 100% on performance. To be eligible for the under-saddle class, animal must have shown in **and completed** an over-fences class. Under-saddle class animals will be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. Not required to jog for over-fences classes.

WPCSA LOW HUNTER 18" or 2' (Article 112.8)

Division is open to ponies/cobs and Half-Welsh/Partbreds, Juniors and Adults. These **ANIMALS** may not compete in any other over fences division at that show where fence heights exceed 18". There are no restrictions on the rider unless they are restricted by other class rules. Long Stirrup riders are eligible if jumping 18" but Short Stirrup riders are not eligible to compete. Courses to be set at 18" or 2' with a minimum of 4 fences with 8 jumping efforts required. Jumps must be verticals (no cross rails). Riders may choose to jump 18" or 2'. Fence heights are not determined by the height of the animal. No animal may jump both 18" and 2' in this division at the same show. Over-fence classes must precede the under-saddle classes. To be judged 100% on performance. May either trot or canter the course. Not required to jog for over-fences classes.

WPCSA HUNTER (Article 112.5)

Over Fence (O/F): To be shown over a course of a minimum of six fences with eight jumping efforts of the required height. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement, and style; 25% on breed type and conformation. Working Classes are judged 100% on performance. Fence Heights: Animals 13.2 hands and under will jump 2'0", animals over 13.2 shall jump 2'6".

Under Saddle (U/S): To be eligible, animal must have shown in and completed an over fences (o/f) class. To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. May be required to hand gallop one way of the ring but no more than eight animals at one time.

WPCSA HUNTER SEAT EQUITATION (Article 114.3)

Classes open to ponies/cobs/Half-Welsh/Partbred. To be judged on the rider's appearance, seat, hands and control of their mount. Animals 13.2 and under jump 2" animals over 13.2 jump 2'6".

Under saddle (u/s) classes: to be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Tests may be required.

WPCSA RIDDEN WELSH CLASSIC SEC. A&B (Article 115.7)

This class is for registered Welsh Ponies, Section A & B, 4 years of age and over. To be judged 50% on conformation and 50% on performance. Entries shall enter the arena at the walk in a clockwise direction. To be shown on both reins as a group at the walk, trot, and canter with animation. The required individual performance must show all four gaits (the gallop need only be shown in one direction). Each animal will then be stripped and judged for conformation judging, showing at the walk and trot, in hand, by the rider. Once an entry has been judged for conformation it may be retacked. Class is an English class only. No Western, Saddle Seat or Side Saddle tack or attire. Qualified UK or American Judge to officiate.

WPCSA RIDDEN WELSH CLASSIC SEC. C & D (Article 115.7)

This class is for registered Welsh Cobs and Welsh Ponies of Cob Type 4 years of age and over. To be judged 50% on conformation and 50% on performance. Entries shall enter the arena at the walk in a clockwise direction. To be shown on both reins as a group at the walk, trot, and canter with animation. The required individual performance must show all four gaits (the gallop need only be shown in one direction). Each animal will then be stripped and judged for conformation judging, showing at the walk and trot, in hand, by the rider. Once an entry has been judged for conformation it may be retacked. Class is an English class only. No Western, Saddle Seat or Side Saddle tack or attire. Qualified UK or American Judge to officiate.

WPCSA RIDDEN WELSH CLASSIC CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS (Article 115.7)

To be judged 50% on conformation and 50% on ridden performance. Open to first and second place winners from the Ridden Welsh A/B Classic and the Ridden Welsh C/D Classic. There is no entry fee for this class. Places will be awarded for the Best Ridden and the Reserve Best Ridden. Any animal in this class is eligible to be named the Best Ridden. Entries shall enter the arena at the walk in a clockwise direction. The Judge shall request all four gaits (walk, trot, canter, gallop) in at least one direction, but animals need not show in both directions. The judge shall consider the size of the ponies/cobs, ages of riders, safety of arena when determining whether to have the animals perform as a group or individually. Individual pattern is optional at the judge's discretion. Entries shall not be stripped as conformation score from the qualifying class shall be carried forward.

WPCSA WELSH ENGLISH PLEASURE (Article112.3)

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring on light contact without a martingale. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25% on breed type and conformation. Working class to be judged 100% on performance.

WPCSA WELSH WESTERN PLEASURE (Article 112.4)

To be shown at a walk, jog and lope both ways of the ring without a martingale, on a reasonably loose rein, without undue restraint. To be judged on performance, with emphasis on manners 65%; breed type, conformation and movement 25%; appointments 10%. Working classes are judged 100% on performance.

WPCSA STOCK SEAT EQUITATION (Article 114.5)

Classes are open to ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Riders to be judged on seat, hands, performance of animal, appointments of animal and rider and suitability of animal to rider. Riders enter the ring at a walk or jog and are judged at a flat-footed four beat walk, two-beat jog and a three-beat lope both ways of the ring. All competitors are required to back a straight line during the line up. Tests may be required.

WPCSA WALK-TROT ADULT EQUITATION (Article 115.8)

Class open to riders 18 years of age and older on ponies, cobs, Half-Welsh, or Part Breds. English or Western attire is acceptable. Riders ineligible for any other WPCSA pointed ridden class at that show. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To walk and trot or jog both ways of the ring. Possible tests to include: walk, trot or jog, turn, halt and rein back at spots marked.

ARBUCKLE CELEBRATION OPEN CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Open Costume Liberty

To be judged on imagination and creativity of the presentation and with consideration of the horse's expression and movement. Music should be in the theme of the costume. All adornments should be secure and deemed safe for horse and handlers. The exhibitor and helper enter the arena with the horse. At the first sound of music, the horse is turned loose. The music should be time to exactly one and a half minutes (1 1/2). Once the music stops, the exhibitor has exactly two (2) minutes to catch the horse. Exhibitors may show individually or with the aid of one helper. Youth exhibitors may not present a stallion.

Celebration Open Costume

Class is to be judged on creativity, dramatic and or humorous value, authenticity to period, suitability of costume to horse and handler and manners. Exhibitors may show individually or as a group. Horse may be ridden or lead. It will be at the Judge's discretion to decide if a costume is unsafe or creates an unsafe atmosphere in which case it will be cause for elimination.

Western Pleasure

Open to all riders, horses to be shown at a walk, jog and lope(walk/jog division not to lope) both ways of the ring on a reasonably loose rein, without undue restraint. To be judged 65% on performance with emphasis on manners; 25% on conformation and movement; 10% on appointments. No martingales, tiedowns or cavesons allowed. May use 2 hands with a snaffle or hackamore on any age horse. Any curb bit with a curb strap or curb chain must be ridden with one hand. Proper Western tack and attire required.

Western Horsemanship

Open to all rider to be judged on seat, hands, performance of animal, appointments of animal and rider and suitability of animal to rider. Tests or pattern may be required and will be posted 1 hour before class.

English Pleasure

Open all riders riders, horse to be shown at a walk, trot and canter(walk/trot division not to canter) both ways of the ring, with light contact, without undue restraint. To be judged 65% performance with emphasis on manners; 25% conformation and movement; 10% appointments. No martingales, tiedowns or cavesons allowed. Proper english tack and attire required.

English Equitation

Open to all riders to be judged on seat, hands, performance of animal, appointments of animal & rider and suitability of animal to rider. Tests or pattern may be required and will be posted 1 hour before class.

Pet Pony Obstacle

Open to all horses and ponies for children age 8 and under. Age as of January 1st of this year. To be shown in-hand over and through obstacles at a walk and trot by handlers. To be judged 100% on performance and manners.

In-Hand Trail

Open to all horses and handlers, to be shown in-hand over and through obstacles at a walk and trot. To be judged 100% on performance.

Trail

Open to all horses and riders, English or Western equipment. To be shown over and through obstacles at a walk, optional trot or jog and optional canter or lope. To be judged 100% on performance.

Ranch Riding

Open to all horses and riders to be shown individually. Pattern will be posted at least 1 hour before class. Refer to AQHA rules for this class.
