## ENTRIES TAKEN DAY OF THE SHOW (Only until 9am) PLEASE CALL TO RESERVE STALLS (limited) 386-527-1666

All entry forms must be completed and signed. All horses/ponies showing in WPCSA classes must have a legible copy of the Welsh Certificate of Registration on file with the secretary and a measurement card or be measured.

No food available on grounds – Subway across road.

The judge's decision is final.

All Welsh ponies six years & over, showing in breeding classes and all Welsh, ½ Welsh and Part breds showing in performance classes MUST BE MEASURED or present a valid WPCSA or USEF measurement card. Measuring will be done between 8 and 8:30 AM on show day.

The judge, rules committee or show grounds manager may intercede in any situation that appears unsafe to exhibitors, animals or bystanders to reduce the possibility of accident or injury. Any acts of discourtesy or disobedience to the judge or officials, or the part of the owner, rider or groom shall disqualify the ponies and the owner shall forfeit his/her entry fee and other fees.

Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle or leaving an animal unattended while hitched, anywhere on the show grounds, will result in instant elimination and removal from the show grounds. *Wire Wheeled Vehicles Permitted in all driving classes*.

Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times while on the show ground. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

#### **WPCSA Class Descriptions**

#### WPCSA BREED CLASSES (Article 110.2)

Animals are to be shown in hand at a walk and a trot except in group classes. Purebred Welsh to be judged 85% on breed type, conformation, way of going, quality and substance and 15% on disposition and manners. Natural reaching action is desired. Half-Welsh and Part-bred to be judged 85% on conformation, way of going, quality and substance and 15% on Welsh breed type, disposition and manners.

#### **Performance Classes**

#### WPCSA LEADLINE WALK (Article 115.4)

Classes open to riders 7 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-welsh/part-bred. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount at a walk. To stand quietly. To be led by an adult or a junior age 12 or over. Both handler and rider to be appropriately attired. English or Western attire is acceptable. No chain leadlines. RIDERS ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, leadline walk-trot, and leadline walk-trot poles. WPCSA LEADLINE WALK-TROT (Article 115.4)

Classes open to riders 7 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh/part-bred. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount at a walk and trot/jog. To stand quietly. To be led by an adult or a junior age 12 or over. Both handler and rider to be appropriately attired. English or Western attire is acceptable. No chain leadlines. **RIDERS** ineligible for other ridden classes except costume and leading reina hunter course. The poles should be placed far enough away from the entrance gate to provide an , leadline walk and leadline walk-trot poles.

#### WPCSA LEADLINE WALK-TROT POLES (Article 115.4)

Classes open to riders 7 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh/part-bred. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To be ridden once around a course of four poles on the ground entirely at a walk or entirely at a trot/jog. Poles are to be placed at a minimum of 4 feet off the rail, two on each side of the ring, simulating adequate sized area to do an opening and closing circle. May be ridden at either a walk or trot/jog. To be led by an adult or a junior age 12 or over. Both handler and rider to be appropriately attired. English or Western attire is acceptable. No chain leadlines. **RIDERS** ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, leadline walk and leadline walk-trot.

#### WPCSA WELSH ENGLISH PLEASURE (Article112.3)

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring on light contact without a martingale. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25 % on breed type and conformation. Working class to be judged 100% on performance.

#### WPCSA LOW HUNTER 18" Only (Article 112.8)

Division is open to Ponies/Cobs and Half-Welsh/Part Breds, Juniors and Adults. These **ANIMALS** may not compete in any other over fences division at that show where fence heights exceed 18". There are no restrictions on the rider unless they are restricted by other class rules. Long Stirrup riders are eligible if jumping 18" but Short Stirrup riders are not eligible to compete. Courses to be set at 18" with a minimum of 4 fences with 8 jumping efforts required. Over-fences classes must precede the under-saddle classes. To be judged 100% on performance. May either trot or canter the course. Not required to jog for over-fences classes.

#### WPCSA WELSH HUNTER (Article 112.5)

Over fences (o/f): To be shown over a course of a minimum of **six** fences with eight jumping efforts of the required height. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25% on breed type and conformation. Working classes judged 100% on performance. Animals not exceeding 13.2 hands will jump 2'.0", animals exceeding 13.2 shall jump 2'6".

Under saddle(u/s): To be eligible, pony must have shown in and completed an over fence class. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. May be required to hand gallop one way of the ring, but no more than eight animals at one time.

#### WPCSA PLEASURE DRIVING (Article 113.1)

To be shown to a suitable two or four-wheeled vehicle or four-wheeled vehicle for pairs, but not a viceroy, racing sulky or fine harness rig. To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, working trot and trot on and stand quietly and except for tandems, **to back readily.** To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25% on breed type and conformation. Working classes are judged 100% on performance.

#### **OPEN DIVISION**

**OPEN HALTER** – open to all horses and ponies, mares, geldings & stallions.

OPEN STOCK HALTER - open to all horses and ponies, mares gelding & stallions of Stock Type

**OPEN WALK** – open to all beginner riders, to be ridden both ways of the ring at a walk. To be judged on performance and riders ability to control their mount. Riders not eligible to ride in any canter class.

**OPEN WALK – TROT** – Open to all beginner riders. To be ridden both ways of the ring at a walk and trot. To be judged on performance and riders ability to control mount. Rider is not eligible to ride in any canter class

**OPEN WALK and WALK – TROT GROUND POLES -** Open to all beginner riders. To be ridden over a course of 4 ground poles, entirely at the walk or at the trot. To be judged 100% on performance. Rider not eligible for any canter class.

**OPEN WALK – TROT CROSSRAILS -** Open to all beginner riders. To be ridden over a course of 8 crossrails, maximum of 18". To be ridden entirely at the walk or entirely at the trot. To be judged 100% on performance. Riders are not eligible for any canter class.

CROSSRAIL PATTERN CLASSES - Crossrails will be jumped as a pattern class. To be judged 100% on performance.

CROSSRAIL CHALLENGE - Crossrails will be jumped as a pattern class with at least one change of direction. To be judged 100% on performance

**OPEN HUNTER** - To be shown over a course of 8 fences. Height to be determined by rider – 2' to 2'6". To be judged 100% on performance. **Hunter Hack** will show u/s with 2 fences, hand gallop, halt and back. Judged 100% on performance **Handy Hunter** will show over 8 fences—one fence from a trot and one change of direction. Judged 100% on performance.

**OPEN ENGLISH PLEASURE** - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring on light contact without a martingale. May be asked to extend the trot and/or hand gallop. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25 % on conformation. Working class to be judged 100% on performance.

**OPEN CATALOG RACE** – Riders are timed = enter ring at a safe gait, to a catalogue at the end of arena located on a barrel, tear out their assigned page and return to start line.

**COMMAND CLASSES** – riders are to follow the judge's direction and are eliminated in the order of error in commands.

**Driving Classes** – Will be judged 100% on performance

Reinsmanship Classes - To be judged 100% on Drivers ability to control horse/pony - may be asked for test

Novice Classes are open only to drivers who have never won more than 3 blues in any driving event.

**DERBY CLASSES** – riders will ride a designated course with the optimum time being determined by show staff prior to show.
