Welsh and Half-Welsh/Part Bred - Section A, B, C and D

- All entries must be registered in the stud book of the Welsh Pony Society of America, Inc. or the Welsh Section of the Canadian Pony Society and must be entered under their full registered name, or if under one year, be eligible for registration.
- All halter ponies age 6 and over and all performance ponies must either have a WPCSA permanent measurement card, two WPCSA temporary cards, an USEF measurement card or be measured. <u>Measurement Time</u> - August 31, 2017 between 8:30 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.
- 3. A photocopy of the WPCSA Certificate of Registration in the current owner's name must be presented before the animal can be assigned a number or enter the ring.
- 4. Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched, anywhere on the show grounds, will result in instant elimination from the show grounds.
- 5. Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/ SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times while on the show grounds. Harness must be secure and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.
- 6. This show has applied for a WPCSA Gold Sanctioning Double Point Show by the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America. All ponies shown in the halter classes will pay \$5.00 per pony per judge and if not shown in Halter, but Performance only the fee will be \$5.00.
- 7. At the discretion of the Superintendent, classes may be combined, divided or canceled.
- 8. Permanent stalls with doors are provided and are available on a first come first serve basis unless otherwise notified.
- 9. Entry fee is \$5.00 per class unless otherwise stated. Post entries will be accepted in group classes only.
- 10. No bedding material other than straw may be used. Exhibitors must clean out their stalls and place the manure in designated areas.
- 11. All animals over nine months of age must have a certificate indicating a Negative Coggins Test made within 12 months prior to show date. Photocopy stamped by the appropriate animal health official of the respective State will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate.
- 12. Foals may accompany their dams in the ring but must be led.
- 13. Animals entered in group classes must be entered in an individual class.
- 14. Entries will be accepted on a first come first taken basis and may be limited to available stall space.
- 15. No refunds will be given after closing date of pre-entries.
- 16. Veterinarian and Farrier will be available on the fairgrounds.
- 17. Every pony entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show, the Maryland State Fair Welsh Pony Show, its directors, employees and the officials blameless for any loss or accident to his pony, employee, equipment, which may occur froms sickness, fire, or otherwise.

Purebred Welsh to be judged 85% on breed type, conformation, way of going, quality and substances and 15% on disposition and manners. Natural reaching action is desired. Half-Welsh and Partbreds to be judged 85% on conformation, way of going, quality and substance and 15% on Welsh breed type, disposition and manners.

WPCSA Leadline Walk (Article 115.4)

Class open to rider 7 years and under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-welsh/partbred, mares and geldings. See rules for attachment of leading rein. No chain leadlines allowed. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount at a walk and walk-trot. To stand quietly. To be led by an adult or a junior age 12 or over. Both handler and rider to be appropriately attired. English or Western attire is acceptable. RIDERS ineligible for other ribbon classes except costume, leading rein, leadline walk, leadline walk-trot, and leadine walk-trot poles.

WPCSA Walk-Trot (Article 115.5)

Class open to rider 11 years and under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-welsh/partbred, mares and geldings. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. English or Western attire is acceptable. Possible test to include: walk, trot/jog, turn, hald and rein back at spots marked. RIDERS ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk and walk-trot poles.

WPCSA Welsh English Pleasure (Article 112.3)

Classes open to ponies/cobs/half-welsh/partbred, mares and geldings. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring on light contact without a martingale. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25% on breed type and conformation. Working class to be judged 100% on performance.

WPCSA Pleasure Driving (Article 113.1)

Classes are open to Section A and Section B mares, geldings and stallions. To be shown to a suitable two or four-wheeled vehicle or four-wheeled vehicle for pairs, but not a viceroy, racing sulky or fine harness rig. Use of a bike style vehicle with floorboards and a basket is acceptable. To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, working trot and trot on and stand quietly and except for tandems, to back readily. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25% breed type and conformation. Working classes are judged 100% on performance.

WPCSA Walk-Trot Adult Equitation (Article 115.8)

Open to riders 18 years of age and older on ponies, cobs, Half-Welsh or Part-Breds. English or Western attire is acceptable. Riders ineligible for any other WPCSA pointed ridden class at this show. Year end high score award for the class will be given. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To walk and trot or jog both ways of the ring. Possible tests to include: walk, trot or jog, halt and rein back at spots marked.

WPCSA Short Stirrup Hunter (Article 112.6)

Open to riders 12 years and under. Classes are open to all ponies/cobs/half-welsh/partbred, mares and geldings. RIDERS in this division, including the under saddle class, may not compete over fences in any other division except Short Stirrup Equitation. Courses to be set at 18" with a minimum of 4 fences with 8 jumping efforts required. May either trot or canter the course. Over fence classes must precede the under saddle class. To be judged 100% on performance. To be eligible for the under saddle class, animal must have shown in **and completed** an over fences class. Under saddle class animals will be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. Not required to jog for over fences classes.

WPCSA Short Stirrup Equitation (Article 114.1)

Open to riders 12 years and under. Classes are open to all ponies/cobs/half-welsh/partbred, mares and geldings. To be judged 100% on hands, seat, control and suitability of mount. Over Fences: Course to be set at 18" with a minimum of 4 fences with eight jumping efforts required. Animals may either trot or canter the entire course. The over fences class must preced the under saddle class. Under Saddle: Animals must walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. RIDERS entering these classes, including the under saddle class, may not compete over fences in any other division except Short Stirrup Hunter.

WPCSA Welsh Hunter (Article 112.5)

To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25% on bred type and conformation. Working classes judged 100% on performance. Animals not exceeding 13.2 hands will jump 2'0"; animals exceeding 13.2 hands shall jump 2'6". Over Fences: to be shown over a course of a minimum of six fences with eight jumping efforts of the required height. Under Saddle: To be eligible, pony must have shown in **and completed** an over fence class. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. May be required to hand gallop one way of the ring but no more than eight animals at one time.
